On July 22, 2025, the Complaints Authorization Committee (CAC) of the College of Pharmacy of Newfoundland and Labrador (CPNL) issued a decision stating that it is of the opinion that there are reasonable grounds to believe that Denise Neil, registration number 93-692, has engaged in conduct deserving of sanction pursuant to Complaint File 2024-179-93-692. The CAC instructed the Registrar & CEO of CPNL to refer the complaint to the CPNL disciplinary panel for a hearing.

Under the authority of section 38(8) of the Pharmacy Act, 2024, the CAC has restricted Ms. Neil's practice pending the final outcome of the disciplinary hearing. The restrictions are as follows:

- a. Ms. Neil must limit her practice to circumstances in which she is directly supervised by another pharmacist registered with CPNL and approved by CPNL to act in that supervisory capacity;
- b. Prior to practicing, Ms. Neil must provide any pharmacist who will be acting in a supervisory capacity to her practice and the pharmacist-in-charge at that pharmacy (if different) with a copy of the CAC's Decision and the associated Investigation Report, and the supervisor must be approved by CPNL in a manner to be determined by the Registrar & CEO or a designate;
- c. Ms. Neil must not act as pharmacist-in-charge or in a preceptor role.

Notice of the date of the hearing will be provided in advance of the hearing. Details of the complaint will be available at the hearing.
